### **Australia and New Zealand** (English)

ISEP-Direct only; excellent chance of ISEP-Direct placement; institutions follow the Southern Hemisphere calendar: full year students should consider applying in September to begin their placement in February instead of July.

### **Japan** (English, Japanese)

*Toyo University*: minimum of one year of college-level Japanese language required. In addition to regular classes taught in Japanese, some courses are taught in a combination of Japanese and English. For more details, please see the Toyo [Highlight of the Month](#). *ISEP-Direct openings are limited.*

### **Malta** (English)

Semester 2 only. Chances for ISEP-Direct are expected to be good. Apply no later than September 1.

### **Spain** (Spanish)

Students must have 6 semesters of Spanish language courses at the college-level before departure to participate on exchange in Spain. For placement on the ISEP-Direct Spanish language and Culture program in Murcia, a minimum of four semesters of Spanish must be completed prior to departure.

The first semester at Spanish universities ends in February. Full-year or spring semester placements are more compatible with the U.S. academic calendar.

Note: The ISEP-Direct program in *Murcia*, if only taken for one semester, follows the U.S. academic calendar. Fall language program may be combined with spring-semester (reciprocal or Direct) immersion in regular academic program.

[\*ISEP-Direct Spanish Language Bridge Program at Navarra\*](#) is an intensive 4-week (100 hours) pre-session language program offered at Navarra in January. It is designed for students who have four semesters of college-level Spanish and want to gain a year's worth of Spanish credit in a short time in order to prepare themselves for an exchange placement in Spain.

### **Argentina** (Spanish)

*Salvador*: 5 semesters of university-level Spanish required. Follows Southern Hemisphere calendar. ISEP-Direct program in Spanish language and Argentine culture for students at elementary and low intermediate levels will be available starting July 2007. ### **Chile** (Spanish)

*Pontificia Universidad Católica de Valparaíso*: Chances of ISEP-Direct placement are excellent for students with at least 5 semesters of Spanish. The ISEP-Direct summer program offers classes for beginner (pre-requisite: 2 semesters of Spanish), intermediate and advanced students; may be combined with SM1. Follows Southern Hemisphere calendar.

**Germany (German)**

Students with less than 2 semesters of German language study can earn a full year's worth of credit through the ISEP-Direct program at Marburg, which combines 4 months of intensive German language study (fall or spring) with a summer program in German politics, economics and culture; no previous German language background required, but intermediate and advanced courses are available.

**Italy (Italian)**

Intermediate/advanced level Italian language required at Pavia and Urbino on ISEP-Direct; language courses available at both sites.

**Brazil (Portugese)**

*PUC-Rio*: Intermediate-level Portuguese required; language courses offered pre-session (fee-paid) and during the semester (included). Follows Southern Hemisphere calendar.
