## LOCATION

## PROGRAM DETAILS

Five-week Brazilian Language, History and Culture. Students will attend 4-hour classes in the afternoon, from Monday to Friday. The program includes weekly cultural activities: a Brazilian Cooking class, a Jewelry Workshop, two Literature Classes, and a tour of Downtown Sao Paulo.

## SUBJECTS

1. The study of the Portuguese Language; 2. History, Geography and Brazilian Culture; 3. Introduction to Brazilian and Portuguese Literatures

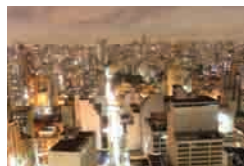
**Brazilian Cooking Class:** students learn about our vast Brazilian menu and prepare some of our typical dishes with professional chefs. A delicious and funny class!

**Jewelry Workshop:** FAAP is one of the most well-known schools of Arts in Brazil and because of that we can add in our Portuguese Program a 3-hour jewelry Workshop - an interesting opportunity for the students to learn about the jewelry technique and produce their own piece of jewelry (made of metal) in a professional and enjoyable atmosphere.

**Literature Classes:** students will learn about the most important Brazilian and Portuguese authors and their main works.

Brazilian songs and a bit of dance are part of the program.

**Tour of São Paulo:** students visit historical downtown and the City Council Market (the traditional 'Mercado Municipal') where they can try the famous 'pastel de bacalhau' and 'sanduíche de mortadela'. Learn Portuguese through our History and Culture.

## ELIGIBILITY

This program is for students who are fluent in Spanish (either native Spanish speakers or speakers of Spanish as a second language – intermediate level or above) or for students who studied Portuguese before and are in A2 level according to the European Framework of Reference. Once students are in Brazil, they must take a placement test and have an interview with the Coordinator.

Health insurance with coverage of all medical expenses in Brazil is required.
