A 6-week Spanish Learning Program

LOCATION

Pontificia Universidad Católica de Valparaíso

Valparaíso, located 70 miles from Santiago, is the cultural and legislative capital, and the main commercial harbor of Chile. A few miles north lies Viña del Mar, Valparaíso's sister city and Chile's premier beach resort.

PROGRAM DETAILS

Spend six weeks studying Spanish language and Chilean culture at the Pontificia Universidad Católica de Valparaíso. The Program includes day excursions to the Cabalgata Dunas de Ritoque and the Vineyards of Casablanca, and a weekend excursion to Cajón del Maipo in the Andes Mountains and the capital city of Santiago.

ADVANCED LEVEL STUDENTS

Students will take two of four courses (Spanish Grammar, Spanish Conversation & Chilean Culture, Contemporary Chilean Literature, Social & Political Issues in Modern Chile). Eligibility: 4-5 semesters of college-level Spanish or the equivalent.

INTERMEDIATE & BEGINNER LEVEL

Students will take Spanish Grammar and Spanish Conversation, Chilean Culture. Eligibility: Intermediate - 3-4 semesters of college-level Spanish or the equivalent. Beginner- 2 semesters of college-level Spanish or the equivalent.

HOUSING AND MEALS

Students live with Chilean host families and meals are provided.
