## LOCATION

Universidad Nacional-UNA, Heredia city, located in the Central Valley is surrounded by coffee plantations and rainforest parks with a year-round spring climate, is known as "The city of Flowers", a small yet comfortable city to live and study.

## PROGRAM DETAILS

UNA offers a 5 week cultural immersion language program for beginners, intermediate and advanced level students. Learn the Spanish language and the Costa Rican culture at the same time plus having the experience of living with a host family. The program provides airport pick-up and drop-off, on-site Orientation, pre-departure information, plus support from the coordinator. Host family benefits include three meals a day. In addition, the program offers 2 one-day field trips and 2 cultural activities: a Costa Rican Cooking Class and Costa Rican Dance Class included in the program fee.

## COURSES AND CREDITS

Upon arrival students will take a placement test. Classes meet three hours a day five days a week. The four credit course is comprised of 54 course hours, plus seven hours a week of independent study.
