Week 3 St. Kyiv-Mohyla Academy in Kiev — established in 1654 and widely recognized as the leading and most forward-looking university in Ukraine

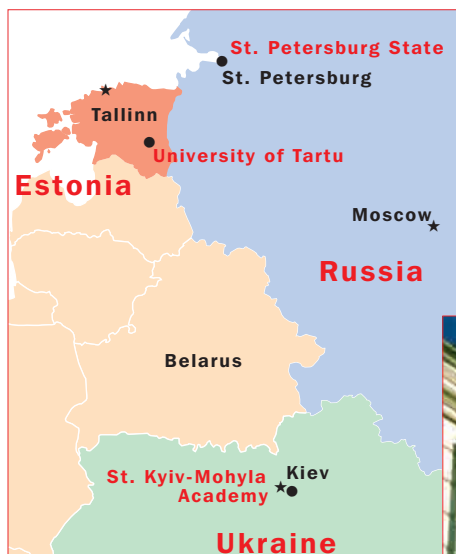
