COURSES AND CREDITS

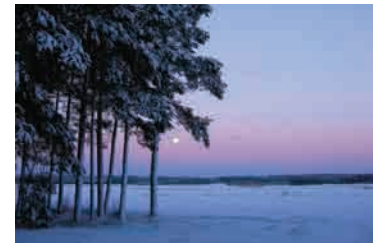
Participants are welcome to take the full summer school program (one course per week) or parts of it. Each course consists of 24 contact hours (2-4 ECTS credits).
