**LOCATION** Hyderabad, the dynamic capital of Andhra Pradesh.

The city is known for both its unique cultural identity that incorporates both the Hindi and Muslim faiths and its role as India's information technology hub. This vibrant city is ideally located in central India serving as a gateway to both the North and South.

Situated on 2,300 acres of rolling hills on the outskirts of the city, the University of Hyderabad is one of India's most attractive and best-equipped campuses. Founded in 1974, UoH is currently home to approximately 2000 students. All course instruction is in English.

### PROGRAM DETAILS

During this six week summer term, the University of Hyderabad Study India Program (SIP) emphasizes the study of heritage, continuity and change in India. Study tours to nearby areas of historical and cultural interest are part of the program.

### COURSES AND CREDITS

Interdisciplinary in nature, with participating faculty from various schools, departments and research centers at the university, SIP offers excellent coursework options. Students enroll in 2-3 classes (each worth 3 credits) from a select list of courses in anthropology, communications, English, folk culture studies, languages, Indian philosophy, and Women's Studies.

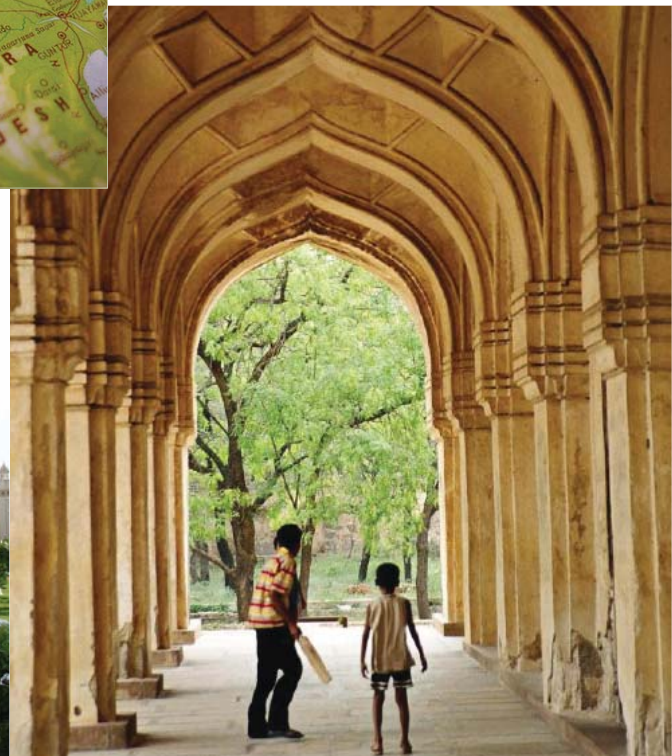
