PROGRAM DETAILS

South Africa: A Decade of Democracy and Beyond

COURSES AND CREDITS

6 US (12 ECTS) credits

Required courses:

- Introduction to South African History, Politics and Economics
- Social, Legal and Cultural Landscapes

Additional choice of one of the following:

- Botanical Diversity of South Africa: Cape Flora – plants for the people of the Western Cape
- Apartheid & After: Representations of South Africa in Art and Literature
- Understanding the HIV/AIDS Epidemic

EXCURSIONS

- Excursions are planned according to the modules being offered. Field trips that are planned for ALL participants are visits to places of historic importance such as Robben Island, places of natural beauty such as Cape Town and Cape Point, Table Mountain and a weekend in the Cedarberg Wilderness area.
- Optional: Garden Route Tour at end of program (approx. \$475 US).
