## LOCATION

Thanks to its modern industry and trade, Brazil has the largest economy in South America. From the Amazon rainforest to famous beaches and sprawling cities, it is a land known for social, cultural, and ecological diversity. São Paulo, an important cultural center, is also its commercial and industrial center. As a popular destination for visitors, it supports first-rate museums, concerts, and experimental theater and dance. Higienópolis is also one of the most traditional districts of São Paulo and the fourth largest city in the world.



## PROGRAM DETAILS

**Extensive Portuguese Course:** Students with little or no Portuguese can take one semester of extensive language courses plus the option of an additional semester of regular courses.

This program includes Portuguese language, Brazilian History and Geography, Brazilian Culture, Brazilian and Portuguese Literature, trips around the city of São Paulo, and a master class in Brazilian Gastronomy.

**Study in English:** FAAP offers this *Study in English* program for students with little or no Portuguese language proficiency.

Courses taught in English are International Business (45 hours), Brazil Interdisciplinary Perspectives (45 hours), Brazilian Culture (45 hours), and Doing Business in Brazil (45 hours). Additionally, students must also enroll in the Extensive Portuguese language course.



## HOUSING AND MEALS

Students stay with host families or in student residences near campus. A meal stipend is provided.
