LOCATION

The historic city of Milan is the capital of Lombardy in the central Po valley, which is Italy's richest, most populated, and most economically active region. Milan is known as one of the world capitals of fashion and hosts a wealth of monuments, palaces, churches, and museums.



PROGRAM DETAILS

Courses in English are offered in the following fields: business, international relations, history, art, music, and Italian culture. Students with intermediate-level Italian may take one or two regular university courses in Italian in addition to the English-taught program. Students proficient in Italian language may enroll in regular courses at the university. During each semester, support language courses are offered at beginning to advanced levels (up to 15 hours per week). See the online ISEP Membership Directory for specific course information.

Pre-session: The university also offers an Italian language and culture pre-session prior to both the fall and spring semesters.

HOUSING AND MEALS

All students are housed in off-campus apartments. ISEP-Exchange students receive a stipend to cover meal costs. ISEP-Direct programs do not include meals.
