LOCATION

Universidad de Murcia, founded in the 13th Century, is a highly ranked public university in the capital city of the autonomous region of Murcia. The city, located on the Mediterranean in southeastern Spain, is the product of civilizations (Muslim, Castilian and Valencian-Aragones) that have crossed throughout its history.



PROGRAM DETAILS

Students are placed into intermediate or intermediate-advanced Spanish language courses after taking a placement test. A variety of workshops highlight aspects of Spanish culture and help students improve their language skills. Course topics include writing, oral lexicon, geography, art history, Spanish history, literature, music, communications, and politics and society. Full-year students may spend an additional semester in the Language and Culture Program or enroll in regular university courses in SM2. Excursions to local sites of interest are also included in the program.

Eligibility: Sophomores are welcome to apply. Four semesters of university-level Spanish or the equivalent are required.

HOUSING AND MEALS

Students are housed in shared flats with other Spanish and international students. A stipend covers rent and meals.

Semester 1: September – December
Semester 2: January – May/June
