## LOCATION

The FAAP campus is located in Higienópolis, one of the most traditional districts of São Paulo. The city is the fourth largest in the world and one of the most vibrant.

## PROGRAM DETAILS

This 5-week program focuses on Brazilian language, history, and culture and includes weekly activities such as an introduction to Brazilian song and dance, a Brazilian cooking class, a jewelry-making workshop, two literature classes, and a tour of Downtown São Paulo, where students visit the City Council Market (the traditional Mercado Municipal) and try the famous pastel de bacalhau and sanduíche de mortadela.

## COURSES AND CREDITS

Students attend courses on weekdays (4 hours per day / 100 hours total). The courses include Portuguese language; History, Geography, and Brazilian Culture; and Introduction to Brazilian and Portuguese Literature.

**Eligibility:** Students must be fluent in Spanish — either native Spanish speakers or speakers of Spanish as a second language (intermediate or above), or they must have studied Portuguese and be in the A2 level (according to the European Framework of Reference). Once in Brazil, students take a placement test and have an interview with the ISEP Coordinator.



## HOUSING AND MEALS

A stipend for housing and meals is provided. Students may stay with a host family or in an on-campus residence.

\$2,300 includes tuition, housing, and meals. Plus a \$60 non-refundable application fee.
