LOCATION

Suwon, located about 20 miles from Seoul, offers all the advantages of city life along with opportunities to visit unique historical sites such as the Hwaseong Fortress, which once enclosed the entire city. The city has grown from its origins as a small village to become a major industrial, educational, and cultural center.



PROGRAM DETAILS

Students study Korean and Asian studies as well as international business. Classes are taught in English, but students must take the Korean Culture Workshop as part of their curriculum. Students also participate in weekly cultural field trips and enjoy small class sizes.

COURSES AND CREDITS

The summer program consists of two 3-week tracks. Students can take up to 4 credits per track.

Excursions: The program includes a 3-day field trip to the beautiful Jeju Island, where students experience aspects of traditional Korean culture and history outside of the classroom environment.

HOUSING AND MEALS

Students are placed in an on-campus dormitory or with a host family. A stipend is provided to purchase meals at the cafeteria or off campus.
