LOCATION

Universidad Regiomontana is situated in the city center of Monterrey, considered the industrial hole of Mexico because nearly 10,000 industries operate within the state, the most prominent of which involve the production of foods, glass, cement, metal slabs, iron, beer, chemicals, and machinery.

PROGRAM DETAILS

Students can choose between two 4-week courses: Doing Business in Mexico or Mexican Culture and Cuisine. Additionally, intensive Spanish classes can be arranged upon request but are not included in the ISEP benefits.

COURSES AND CREDITS

Doing Business in Mexico (40 hours total): This course provides the necessary tools to conduct business in Mexico's rapidly growing economy and rich environment of cultural diversity. Visits to various companies complement the overall course.

Mexican Culture and Cuisine (40 hours total): Because of the mix of Spanish and indigenous cultures, Mexican traditions include diverse ceremonies, food, ideas, and beliefs. This course allows students to discover it all!

The program may include 30 additional hours of Spanish language instruction. Students receive a university certificate after the course.

Eligibility: Open to all applicants. No prerequisites required.

Excursions: Both courses include excursions related to the content. Field trips planned for all students are visits to places of historic and cultural importance such as Silver City Zacatecas, the Magical Village, the Ghost Town of Real de Catorce, and Monterrey's beautiful waterfalls and caves.
