LOCATION

The charming university town of Stellenbosch is ideally situated in the heart of the Cape Winelands, surrounded by magnificent mountains, 20 minutes from the nearest beaches, and 50 minutes from Cape Town.

PROGRAM DETAILS

Learning Through Community Engagement is a 5-week program focusing on the historical background and current issues impacting community life in South Africa, which students will experience firsthand through service to a South African community.

COURSES AND CREDITS

7 US credits (14 ECTS)

The minimum number of participants for this program is 8, and the maximum is 25; students will be notified of acceptance by March 16. Students not accepted will be given the option of joining an alternate program in Stellenbosch focusing on a variety of academic topics.

Eligibility: 3 semesters of university-level courses and 3.0 GPA.

Excursions: These trips are planned according to the modules being offered. However, trips for all participants include visits to places of historic importance such as Robben Island and to places of natural beauty such as Cape Town and Cape Point, Table Mountain, and a weekend in Swellendam. There is also an optional Garden Route Tour at end of program (\$520 US).
