### LOCATION

The charming university town of Stellenbosch is ideally situated in the heart of the Cape Winelands, surrounded by magnificent mountains, 20 minutes from the nearest beaches, and 50 minutes from Cape Town.

### PROGRAM DETAILS

Nation-Building and Development is a 4-week summer program consisting of lectures, group discussions, and field trips. The program covers topics such as history, politics, art, literature, biodiversity, and sociology.

### COURSES AND CREDITS

6 US credits (12 ECTS)

Students are required to take South African History and Politics and have an additional choice of one of the following courses:

- Biodiversity: Plants for the People in the Western Cape
- Apartheid and After: Representations of South Africa in Art
- Apartheid and After: Representations of South Africa in Literature
- Understanding the HIV/AIDS Epidemic
- Challenges for Democratic Consolidation

**Eligibility:** 3.0 GPA.

**Excursions:** These trips are planned according to the modules being offered. However, trips for all participants include visits to places of historic importance such as Robben Island and to places of natural beauty such as Cape Town and Cape Point, Table Mountain, and a weekend in Swellendam. There is also an optional Garden Route Tour at the end of the program (\$520 US).
