Location: Chambéry

Chambéry is an average-size town located at an important crossroads in the heart of the French Alps. It is about three hours from Paris and the Mediterranean coast. Tourists enjoy the area for its Alpine and cross-country skiing and water sports. It is well connected to major French and European cities by high speed train, the TGV.

Institut Savoisien d'Etudes Françaises (ISEFE) at the Université de Savoie

ISEFE is a university institute which specializes in teaching French as a foreign language to students from non-Francophone countries.

Courses and Credits

French language and culture courses are provided for beginner, intermediate, and advanced students. Courses aim to expand students' knowledge of French culture while honing their reading, speaking, and listening skills. Students are placed in appropriate language levels according to a placement exam taken upon arrival.

Program includes 15hrs/wk instruction, 3hrs/wk monitored language lab, and 3 workshops on aspects of local life. Total hours of instruction with lab: 108 hours (5-6 U.S. credits, depending on your university's transfer policy).

Eligibility and Application

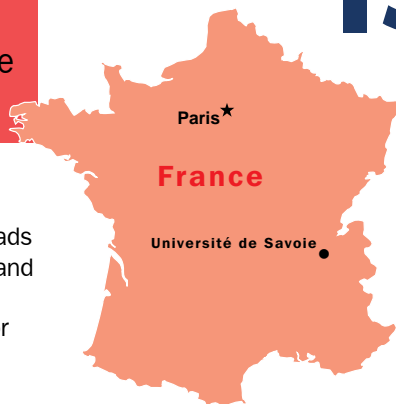
Full-time students from ISEP member institutions and affiliates at the sophomore level or above in any major, at any French language proficiency, and in good academic standing may apply. Minimum GPA: 2.75. See your ISEP coordinator and download ISEP's summer program application from www.isep.org.
