Study Spanish and participate in community
service in Uruguay this summer

Location: Universidad Católica del Uruguay in
Montevideo

The vibrant Capital City and diverse cultural center surrounded by

Program Details

Spend four weeks studying Spanish language and Latin American
History and Culture at Universidad Católica del Uruguay in Mon-
tevideo. This unique program integrates Community Service and
intermediate-level Spanish language study.

Students will attend classes in the morning and participate in
community service in the afternoon. The program includes weekly
cultural activities (theatre, tango, etc.) and a tour of Montevideo.
Guided visits to some of the following sites are included as well:
the coastal towns and beaches of Colonia del Sacramento, Punta
del Este, and Rocha, and the hot springs of Salto and Paysandú
—cattle towns on the Argentine border.

Students live with host families (21 meals/week) or in a university
residence (stipend for 21 meals/week).

Community Service Projects

Projects are administered by the Faculty of Human Sciences and
include serving the underprivileged and marginalized populations
in state institutions and non-governmental organizations such as
schools, youth centers, hospitals, and displaced communities.

Eligibility

Four semesters of college-level Spanish or the equivalent.
