ISEP Website

- The ISEP logo is always a quick-link back to the homepage.
- The homepage menu is organized by the ISEP audiences.
- The student section is a micro-site with its own menu.
- The left red bar contains side sub-menus on many pages.
- The Coordinator section will evolve slowly over the next month in conjunction with our new online database system.
- The new Faculty and Staff section is under construction, and will be online next month.
- The Directory – far right on the top blue menu – is your quick guide to finding a site by state/country.
- The site was designed at the resolution for 90% of our audience at a 1024 X 768 pixel screen resolution. If you cannot see the whole page in one screen, consider adjusting your monitor settings (right click anywhere on the desktop; go to Properties; Settings).
- The overwhelming majority of the photos on the site were donated to us by ISEP students and Coordinators.
- Pages from the old site that will remain active until transferred: Coordinators section, Highlights of the Month, and Photo Essays. You may encounter some broken links within the old pages of the website; we apologize for this. The old site is only being maintained as absolutely necessary, as we are concentrating on transitioning to the new site.

Important Links/Terms

Quick Links are on the Student homepage under the three photos for most frequently used pages

US Students – any student whose home institution is in the USA

International Students - any student whose home institution is outside the USA

Finding the Right Site – factors to consider in choosing an ISEP program

Directory – a listing of all sites alphabetically by country or state, with a link to description

Search for a Program – a search engine with fields of study by language

Sites Open for Applications – listing of the sites with space still available for the upcoming semester. Should be checked by Coordinators and students before applications are submitted.

Study in the USA – has information about selecting and applying to a US site, student visas, and working in the USA

International-to-International – information for international students who wish to study in a country other than the USA

Application fees – found in Programs & Costs → see Exchange or Direct

ISEP-Direct fees - found in Programs & Costs → ISEP-Direct → Continue to ISEP-Direct site
