Q & A

1. Q: What about when a school on the Sites Available List disappears right after advising a student on applying there and submitting the application?
A: It's estimated information and we do the best we can. If there is a specific demand for the school please indicate it on the application, and we will take it into consideration.

2. Q: What is the equivalent of 30 ECTS credits? Many students require that per semester.
A: In the US the regular academic load is 15 credits, 4 or 5 credits, which is different from other countries.

3. Q: American incoming students have more problems with credit transfers. Outgoing students sign contracts before leaving.
A: It is up to the home university how credits transfer and it is the student's responsibility to find out before they leave. International coordinators can print out info from the IIS about credit transfers to give to students as well.

4. Q: What if the restricted choice is in the top 3 but not the first?
A: Don't bother putting it on the application if it's not the first because there are enough students who have it as their first choice to fill all the spaces available. There won't be space left for people who have it as 2nd or third choice.
